### Appointments and emergency care

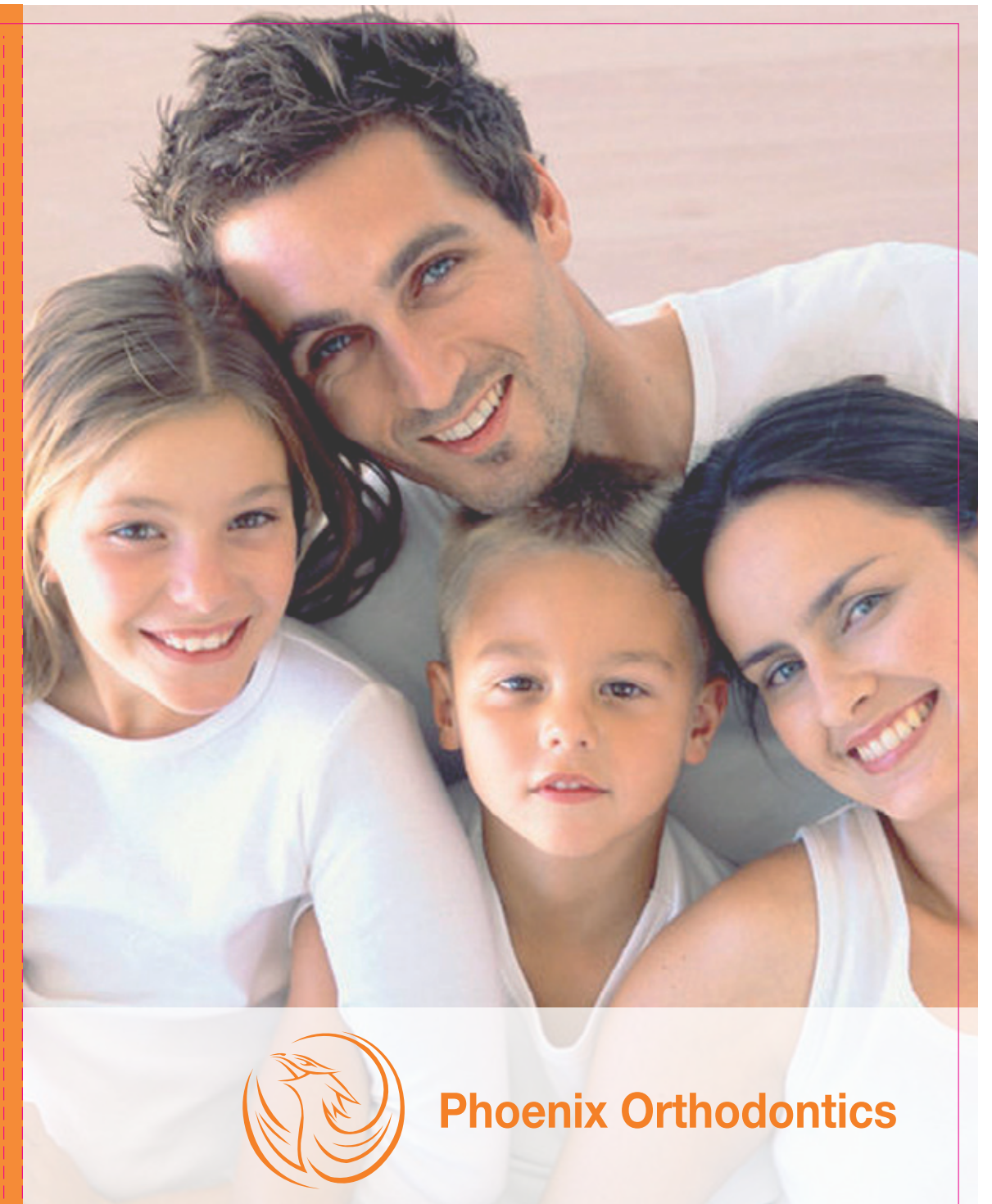
